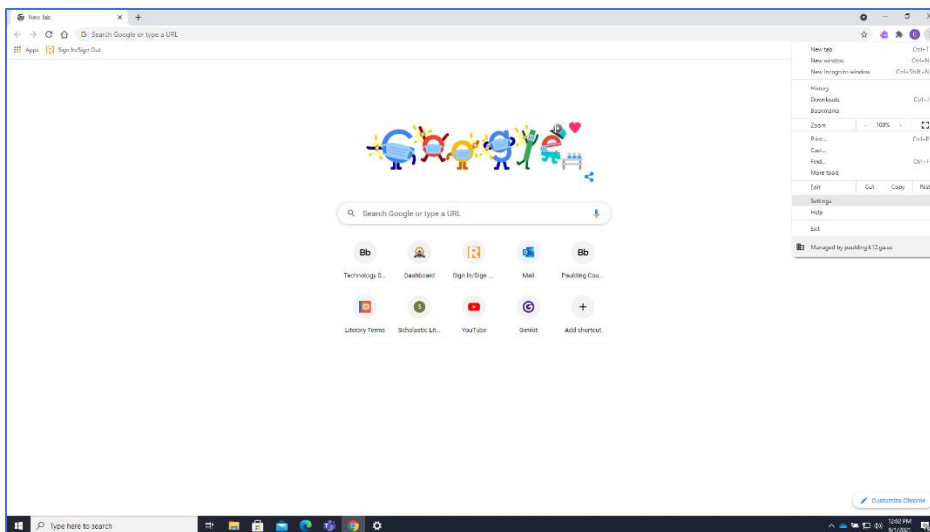


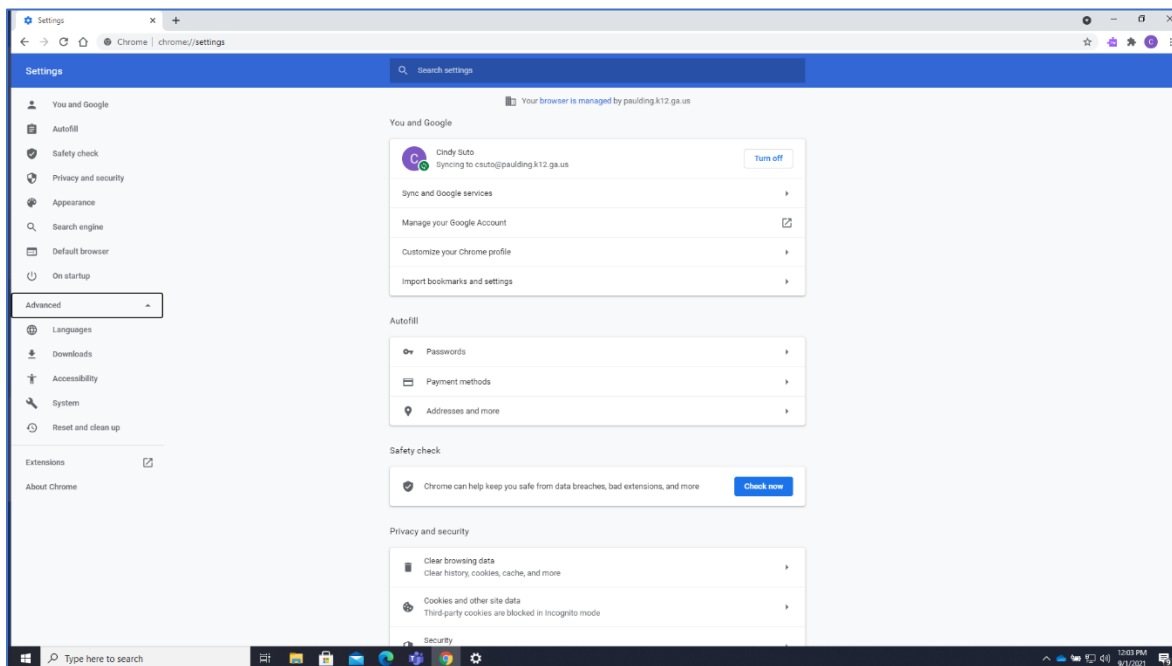
Chrome Live Captioning Steps

To add **Live Captioning for Audio and Videos in Chrome** follow these steps below:

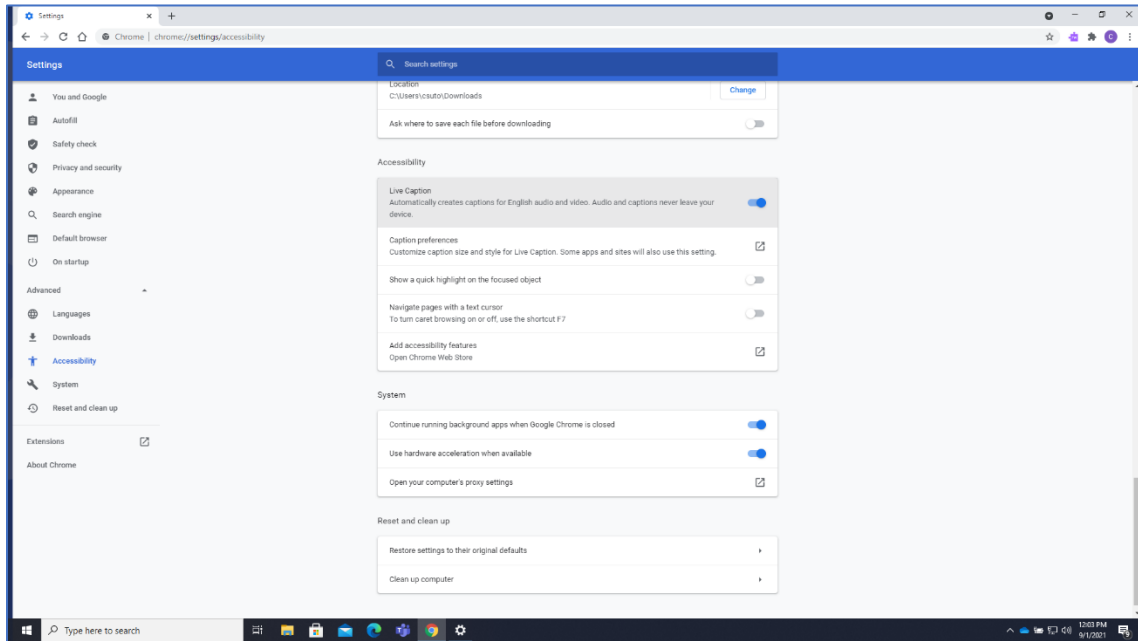
1. In **Chrome**, go to the righthand corner and click on the **3 dots** to get a drop down menu.



2. Click on **Settings** and click on **Advanced** on the lefthand side to **expand the Advanced options**.



3. Scroll down until you see **Accessibility** and click on **Accessibility** under **Advanced**.



4. The **Accessibility** menu will give you the option to turn on **Live Captioning**. Slide the **grey** button to **blue** and exit out of the **Settings** menus.

- When you watch a video it will add closed captioning to the bottom center of the page.
- You can follow the same steps to turn it off.
- This will be helpful when playing teacher instructional videos and videos in modules.
